## Mobile Giving



If you are new here at Central, take a minute to read this section. It explains some of the things that will happen today in the service so nothing takes you by surprise.

**Communication Card:** Please fill out the communication card and drop it in the baskets as you leave the Dream Center auditorium. If this is your first time here at Central, take your Communication Card to one of the information centers and you will receive a great gift!

**Singing:** We love to express ourselves to God through music. Feel free to jump in and sing along.

**Prayer:** At different times, people on stage may spend some time talking with God. We get to listen in, reflect on our lives, and to connect with God through prayer.

**Communion:** At some point in our service, a tray with bread and juice will be passed around, and people will eat and drink and pass it along. Jesus asked us to do this, so we spend this time in the service remembering and thanking him.

**Offering:** We do collect an offering each week as another way for us to worship God. This usually happens right after communion. There is also a debit card kiosk located in the hallway outside the Dream Center if you prefer to give that way.

**Anointing:** If you need the touch of God on any area of your life, go and share that need with one of the people with a towel on their shoulder, and they will pray for you and anoint you with oil on your forehead. This experience is available at the conclusion of the message.

**Baptism:** During our time together, there may be a baptism in a small pool of water on the stage area during our service. This is a special time for people who want to publicly express that they have committed themselves to following Jesus.

**Note:** There are brochures on baptism available in Connection Hall and at the main entrance.

After the service, it would be great for us to be able to meet you. If there are any questions you have about Central, or there's anything we can help you with, please stop at one of the Information Centers on your way out of the building. We would love to connect with you and help you with your next step here at Central Christian.

## MOVE CLASSES

### FIRST WEDNESDAYS

On the first Wednesday of every month, we'll be launching a new worship experience. It starts with a worship service at 6 p.m. and then we'll break out into classes and meetings throughout the church. Sign up on the Communication Card for one of the three "Move" classes listed below or reschedule your small group or Bible Study to meet Wednesday night after worship that week. Child care is available.



**Ignition (Erik Henry):** Whether you're still investigating the claims of Jesus or are just starting your walk with him, Ignition is the spark that can set you on a course for growth. We'll talk about the foundational beliefs of a Christ-follower, and you'll leave challenged to move in your walk with Jesus.



**Acceleration (Kris Dunlop):** You show up at church. You open the Bible here and there. You pray. But somehow it seems like there should be more to your spiritual life. Acceleration will challenge you to quit waiting for growth to happen in your life and to take responsibility for your own walk with God through spiritual practices.



**Overdrive (Joel Otto):** You have been growing in your walk with Jesus, but you know that it's not all about what you get out of it. Overdrive will teach you about turning your faith outward. It's about giving grace, not just receiving it. It's about serving others rather than looking to be served. Get challenged to become a believer who gives their life away.
