

**Day 21: Romans 8:31-32**

Father God, You are so very kind and loving to Your children. You have given us so many good and perfect gifts - the most perfect is Your Son, our Savior Jesus. Thank You, LORD, for Your demonstration of perfect love. Father, according Your Word, I ask that continue to pour out Your power and protection on my life, my family, and upon Your Church. Transform us, LORD, into a community that looks and loves Jesus. - Amen.

**Day 22: Romans 8:38-39**

LORD, what is more desirable than You? Who is like our God (Psalm 113:5)? What power or circumstance can take You from me? What earthly affection is better than Your Presence? Nothing, LORD! Nothing! Not the lies of the evil one or the false promises of this world can rob Your love and Salvation that You have given me by the sacrifice of Your Son, Jesus. Hallelujah! All praise, glory and honor, wisdom, majesty and power be Yours forever and ever. Amen.

**Day 23: Romans 9:20-21**

Forgive me, God, for making demands on You, for putting my selfish agenda before Your desire for me and for Your church. Forgive me when I have followed the course of this world instead of being led by Your Holy Spirit. You have created me to worship, to give You glory and to proclaim the Good News of Jesus. I want to be used by You, Father. Give me Your strength and Your wisdom to do what is pleasing in Your sight. You are the Potter. I am Your clay. May I honor You. In Jesus name. Amen.

**Day 24: Romans 10:9-13**

Jesus, You are Lord. You are God's Messiah, His Son, who came unto Your own but was rejected and crucified (John 1:11). You rose from the grave on the third day. You gave us Your Holy Spirit, the Father's deposit guaranteeing our inheritance with You forever (Ephesians 1:13-14). You are now seated at the Father's right hand, interceding for us (Romans 8:34). The righteousness I have is not from anything I have done but only what You have done for me. Jesus, You are my Savior and my God. Amen.

**Day 25: Romans 11:33-36**

All praise, glory and honor be Yours O LORD. Forever and Ever! When I consider Your ways, Your judgments, Your works; when I consider Your power and Your might, who am I that You should love me or even give thought to me (Psalm 8:4)? Yet because of Your great love, You sent Your Son into this world to die for my sins (John 3:16). How good, how loving, how kind You are to me. I praise You LORD. I praise You! To You be glory forever. Amen.

**Day 26: Romans 12:1-2**

Heavenly Father, forgive me for being so preoccupied with all those things which are temporary and keep me distracted from the ministry which glorifies Jesus. Help me to reclaim the time and the life that I have wasted and, by the power of the Holy Spirit, devote my entire self, with all Your power that is in me, to seek first Your Kingdom and Your righteousness (Matthew 6:33), for the sake of Christ, my Savior and my Lord. Amen.

**Day 27: Romans 12:3-5**

Gracious Father, forgive my arrogance, forgive my pride, forgive me for being blinded by those affections which take my eyes, my mind, and my devotion away from seeking first Your kingdom and Your righteousness (Matthew 6:33). By Your Holy Spirit, I pray that You will empower me to be Your servant, to live out the faith You have given me, and to be content in the ministry You have appointed me. For Your glory and for the advancement of Your kingdom here on earth just as it is in Heaven. Amen.

**Day 28: Romans 13:8-10**

Father, thank You for your unconditional and unending love for me. You are faithful, God. I give You praise for how good You are. Thank You, Jesus, for Your demonstration of love for me by your sacrifice on the cross, purchasing my salvation. Holy Spirit, I ask that You empower me to love my neighbor with the same love You have for me. Help me that my love will be more than just words so that my testimony will not be just empty noise (1 Corinthians 13:1-3). Help me, Father, to glorify Jesus. For Your glory. Amen.

**Day 29: Romans 14:4**



**Day 30: Romans 15:5-6**

**Day 31: Romans 16:25-27**

You did this to give Yourself glory through my Lord and Savior Jesus. All praise and glory and honor be given to You, forever and ever. - Amen.



# 31 DAY PRAYER GUIDE THROUGH ROMANS

**Day 1: Romans 1:16-17**

Father, I thank you for your Word, for in it you have revealed to us the power of the Gospel and the way of salvation through faith in Jesus, your Son. Help me, Lord, to know Your Word, to remain faithful to Your Word and to be a student of Your Word. - Amen.

**Day 2: Romans 2:1-4**

Father, I have no excuses. I confess to You that I am so quick to pass judgment on others while I do the very same things I am condemning them for. Forgive me, LORD. Forgive me for assuming on Your forgiveness just because I go to church or I say a pray once in a while. Forgive and help me, LORD. May I show the same kindness, compassion and forgiveness to others as You have shown to me (Ephesians 4:32). Amen.

**Day 3: Romans 3:21-24**

Father, I worship You and give You praise for the salvation I have through Jesus, Your Son. Thank You, Father, for the faith You have given me. Thank You for forgiving me of my sin and making me right with You. You are good, LORD. I ask that you help me remember that I am forgiven because of what Jesus has done for me instead of what I have done for myself. Thank You, LORD. Amen.

**Day 4: Romans 4:7-8**

LORD, You are good. I worship You because You have blessed me through the death of Your Son, Jesus, on the cross. You have taken my sin, all my sin, and put it on Jesus. You have taken His perfection, and place it on me. Thank You, LORD. You did this not because I am good enough, or right enough, but because of Your love and Your kindness toward me. Such Good News is too wonderful for me to understand (Psalm 139:6). Thank You for all You have done for me. Amen.

**Day 5: Romans 5:1**

Father, I confess to You that I am anxious about many things. My heart is restless and I have a hard time seeing You and trusting You. Forgive me, LORD. I ask that You guard my heart and my mind so I will be thankful (Philippians 4:6-7). You have always been faithful, Father. May I rest in Your peace, Your protection and Your promises. Thank You for being my good, good Father. - Amen.

**Day 6: Romans 5:2-5**

Good Father, how often have I complained over the simple things; things that make little or no difference but only are an inconvenience to me. Forgive me, LORD. Help me to see that You have given Your best to me and Your plans for me are for my benefit and not to harm me. Thank You by faith I don't have to wait to come to You. You are always there for me and You always hear me. Your love fills me, LORD. May I share that same love with those who need You. Amen.

**Day 7: Romans 5:6-8**

O God, please forgive me for the pride of thinking I was good enough, or right enough, or that I made all the right decisions when You save me through the death of Your Son, my Savior, Jesus. I was none of those things, LORD. The only thing I owned was that I was a sinner. Yet Jesus died for me! I was not good enough but He made me good enough just at the right time. Thank You, LORD. Thank You for Your forgiveness and Your love for me. Amen.

**Day 8: Romans 5:9-11**

Father God, because of Your great love for me You made me right with You. I admit there are times that I don't feel right, or that I've done right, or that I deserve any good thing from You. But You saved me and have forgiven me, not because of what I have done but because of what Jesus did. Thank You, LORD. So I can rejoice—and rejoice even more—because the life of Your resurrected Son is now giving me life, and not just an ordinary life, but an over-abundant life (John 10:10). Hallelujah!

**Day 9: Romans 5:18-19**

Lord Jesus, I worship and give You thanks for what You did for me on the cross. Your loving sacrifice gave me life and forgiveness. Thank You, Lord. May I never take your suffering for granted. May I never worship with low energy and a casual attitude. You gave Your life for me, please help me serve and love You with all my heart, all my soul, all my strength, and with all my mind (Luke 10:27). Amen.

**Day 10: Romans 6:1-4**

Risen Lord, by Your death, burial and resurrection You have freed me from a life of sin and death and gifted me with living in Your grace. Hallelujah! As You, Jesus, were raised to give the Father glory, may this new life that You have given me give the Father glory as well. Holy Spirit, empower me to live in obedience to Jesus through grace and because of grace. Amen.

**Day 11: Romans 6:5-7**

Jesus, all praise be Yours for the power of the cross and the victory of Your resurrection. Thank You, Lord. By Your sacrifice I am now free from sin, freed from its bondage, freed from sin's control over me. Thank You for the promise of the resurrection and the promise of seeing You face to face (1 Corinthians 13:12). I ask for Your power, Lord, to live in the reality and hope of the resurrection, and my death to sin and my life in You. Help me, Lord. For Your glory. Amen.

**Day 12: Romans 6:17-18**

Holy Father, gracious LORD, Creator God, the Author of Everlasting life; You who are Eternal, loving and kind, gifted us with a heart of obedience, not to take away our happiness, but to give us real joy. Thank You, Father, for freeing us from desiring those things which are only temporary and lead to death, and gifting us with a new heart, and a new desire, to pursue You and Your Kingdom, which leads to life and peace and forgiveness. Amen.

**Day 13: Romans 6:22-23**

Eternal God, Giver and Preserver of my life, Author of salvation, Holy is Your Name. All praise glory and honor be Yours, forever and ever. Amen. Thank You, Father, for giving me Your salvation and gifting me with eternal life, through Jesus, my Savior and Lord. May I work with all Your energy to make the most of the salvation You have given me (Philippians 2:12), so that Your free gift will be proven true and give You glory before a world who needs Jesus. - Amen.

**Day 14: Romans 7:21-25**

LORD, I give you praise and thanksgiving for saving me from this life of sin and death. I confess that my sin and my shame are ever before me (Psalm 51:3). But You have rescued me, Father. Hallelujah! Thank You for reminding me that my salvation is found in Jesus my Savior and King, my Hope and my Future with You forever. - Amen.

**Day 15: Romans 8:1-2**

Loving Father, You love me with an everlasting love. You are Faithful and True. I love You, LORD. Thank You for reminding me that I am not defined by the scars of my past but I am one with Jesus who died for my sins. Thank You for Your forgiveness. Thank You for Your mercy. Thank You for giving me life. - Amen.

**Day 16: Romans 8:5-6**

Father of Light, I am bombarded daily with thoughts, images and arguments which are contrary to Your desire for me. Help me, LORD. Help me to take every thought, every desire and every pretense captive and make it obedient to Jesus (2 Corinthians 10:5). Holy Spirit, lead me, direct me, give me wisdom, so that all that I think, say, and do will point to Jesus, my Savior and Friend. Amen.

**Day 17: Romans 8:11**

Faithful Father, thank You for being with me. Thank You for being my helper. Thank You for being my source and my life. When I'm slowed down, beaten down, when I have nothing left, You give me strength and give me life (Isaiah 40:31). Thank You, Father. Keep my eyes focused on You and not on my temporary circumstance. You are greater and more desirable that all this world has to offer. I love You LORD. - Amen.

**Day 18: Romans 8:16-17**

Heavenly Father, Faithful God, the Author of my salvation, You are my Helper. Thank You for the hope of heaven. There is no one I desire more than You and there is nothing on earth that is more desirable than being Your child (Psalm 73:25). Take my pain and suffering and use it to glorify Jesus, and give me a testimony before others that You are good, merciful and kind. I trust You, LORD. For Your glory. - Amen.

**Day 19: Romans 8:26**

Father, I confess to You that I do not know what to pray for. Sometimes the words come hard. Sometimes I do not want to pray. Help me LORD. Jesus, teach me to pray. May the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart give You glory, LORD (Ps. 19:14). May my prayers reflect Your will. May my heart be in tune with Your Spirit. Holy Spirit, please lead and direct my desires so that Christ may be honored in everything I do. Amen.

**Day 20: Romans 8:27-30**

Father, You loved me from the beginning and called me to love You and to love Jesus. I am unworthy, Father, but You love you anyway. I ask for the Spirit's help in making my life to be what You have called me to be. Please remove all pride and boasting in what I have done and let me glorify Jesus and boast in what He has done for me. Thank You, Father, for the gift of salvation through grace. Holy Spirit, make me like Jesus. Amen.
